MINUTES OF THE 26th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Date and Time: 4th July 2019 (Thursday) at 5.15 p.m.

1. Attendance

The AGM was attended by 31 voting members, 1 non-voting member and an observer (attendance list is as shown in Appendix 1). The President, Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor, called the meeting to order at 5.15 pm after the quorum was achieved.

2. Welcome Address by the President

On behalf of MASO 14th Council, Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor thanked members for their presence and support to enable us to achieve the quorum and welcomed them to the 26th AGM. Emeritus Prof. Mohd Ismail Noor informed that the celebration of the Silver Jubilee of MASO and biennially MASO Scientific Conference will be held on 15 and 16 October 2019 in Hotel Istana, Kuala Lumpur. He also encouraged members to be more active in supporting MASO upcoming activities and encourage their research group/students to present papers in MASO 2019.

3. Approval of the Agenda of Annual General Meeting

The AGM began with a vote to approve the Agenda of the AGM. The Agenda was proposed to be approved by Dr. Zawiah Hashim and was seconded by Dr. Wong Jyh Eiin.

4. Minutes of 25th AGM

Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor went through the minutes of the 25th AGM held on the 10th August 2018 at Room Safir I, Hotel Istana, 73 Jalan Raja Chulan, Bukit BIntang, 50200 Kuala Lumpur.

4.1 Confirmation of the Minutes

The minutes of the 25th AGM held on the 10th August 2018 was proposed to be passed by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Zaitun Yassin and seconded by Dr. Denise Koh Choon Lian.

4.2 Matters Arising from the Minutes

No matters arose from the minutes of the 25th AGM.

5. Council Report for 2018-2019

The Honorary Secretary, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hazizi Abu Saad presented the Council Report for 2018/2019. Various MASO activities conducted in 2018 and 2019 were presented to the members. A total of 7 council meetings were held over the past year.

5.1 MASO Membership

As of the end of June 2019, MASO had 173 registered members. The membership status is as follows: Life 85, Ordinary 84, Associate 2, Corporate 2.

5.2 MASO Website

- i) Dr. Mohd Razif Shahril and Dr. Geeta Appannah are the subcommittee for the MASO website, and they had worked with the webmaster to update the MASO website. The website has been updated with information and photographs of MASO activities, including MASO Camp in UPM, Suku Suku Separuh dan Cergas (3SC) Obesity intervention programme as well as UKM and UPM collaborative events. Besides that, announcement of seminar and conferences related to obesity are also included into our website.
- ii) Members are encouraged to log in to MASO website for recent updates on MASO activities and events. The URL is www.maso.org.my. MASO expressed our thanks to Mr Lim Kooi Fong (webmaster) for his continued services to the Association.

5.3 MASO Education Fund

There was no application for Seminar Grant in the past year. However, there a total of 12 members applied for the education grant for attending the Asia-Oceania Conference on Obesity (AOCO) 2019, Seoul, South Korea from 29th till 31st August 2019.

5.4 MASO Activities

Among the activities that were held over the past year was 3SC Program, MASO Seminar Updates, MASO Camp, MASO 10k Steps Challenge and MASO Scientific Conference on Obesity.

a. Suku Suku Separuh and Cergas (3SC) Program

The 3SC is a 6-month lifestyle intervention program being conducted in Selangor and Johor states. Five localities were chosen from each state and these included Tanjung Karang, Olak Lempit, Batu Arang, Beranang and Ulu Yam in Selangor and Ayer Baloi, Sri Gading, Parit Sulong, Bukit Pasir, Batu Anam in Johor. Data collection in Selangor was successfully completed in the first quarter of 2019, while in Johor, the expected completion date will be sometime in October or November 2019. A full report for this program will be prepared before being circulated to Ministry of Health (MOH), Malaysia.

b. MASO Scientific Updates

- i) In conjunction with **the 25th AGM** held on 10 August 2018 (Friday) at Hotel Istana, Kuala Lumpur. Prof. Susan Jebb, a Professor of Diet and Population Health from the Nuffield Department of Primary Care Health Science, University of Oxford, had presented a talk entitled "Diet, Obesity & Health: From Science to Policy".
- ii) For the year 2019, a **MASO Update** was presented in conjunction with the AGM on 4th July (Thursday) at 5.15 p.m. at Hotel Istana, Kuala Lumpur. The President, Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor was the speaker and he shared MASO's various progresses and activities in his presentation entitled '25 Years of MASO: Achievements & Challenges'.

c. MASO Camp

i) MASO successfully organised a MASO Camp event in UPM on 2nd April 2019 among 95 overweight and obese staff in collaboration with Department of Nutrition and Dietetics UPM and KEPERTAMA (Kesatuan Kakitangan Am Universiti Putra Malaysia). Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor (President MASO), Prof. Dr. Muhammad Nazrul Hakim Abdullah, the Deputy Dean (Graduate Study, Industry & Community Relations and Income Generation), Faculty of Medicine

- and Health Sciences, UPM, Mr. Mohd Razali Singah, the President of KEPERTAMA, attended the opening ceremony.
- ii) Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor was invited to give an opening speech and deliver a lecture on the consequences of obesity.
- iii) A total of 94 participants attended the camp, and their KAP and anthropometric data were collected. The feedback was good, and there was a request from KEPERTAMA to follow-up on the participants.
- iv) MASO funded a sum of RM1500 for lunch and printing of bunting and banner, while KEPERTAMA sponsored breakfast on the day of MASO camp.
- v) The event was coordinated by Dr. Geeta Appannah, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hazizi Abu Saad and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Chin Yit Siew, together with other colleagues from the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics UPM.

d. MASO 10k Steps Challenge

- i) MASO continued to organize the MASO 10k Steps Challenge on 13th October 2018 (Saturday) in conjunction with World Obesity Day that is held annually on 11 October.
- ii) The 10K Steps Challenge is a challenge organized as an online social media event. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hazizi Abu Saad coordinated the event using Facebook as the main platform and promoted on the newsfeed of Facebook users. The event reached 7037 Facebook users, 871 of them participated in this event, and 408 who submitted their achievements at the Facebook page received certificates of achievement from MASO.

e. <u>MASO Scientific Conference on Obesity (MASO 2019) in conjunction with MASO 25th Anniversary</u>

- i) MASO Scientific Conference on Obesity 2019 will mark our 25th anniversary (the silver jubilee year) of MASO and will be held on 15-16 October 2019 (Tuesday Wednesday) at Hotel Istana, with the theme of "Obesity: Addressing Multiple Drivers and Solutions".
- ii) MASO Scientific Conference 2019 is also being held in conjunction with World Obesity Day. MASO hopes the conference will be attended by around 150 participants. The President urges the members to encourage their colleagues and students to share their research findings in the conference.
- iii) The proposed programme will include 2 Plenary lectures, Symposia sessions and poster presentations.
- iv) There will also be Young Investigator's competition for oral presentations among postgraduate students of local Universities, and best poster awards for all poster presenters.
- v) For the Opening Ceremony of MASO 2019, MASO have invited the Deputy Minister of Health YB Dr. Lee Boon Chye and YB have agreed to launch MASO 2019.

5.5 MASO Affiliations and other activities

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hazizi Abu Saad went through the list of MASO affiliations and reported the following:

a. World Obesity Federation (WO)

 MASO has been affiliated to the World Obesity Federation (WO), previously known as International Association for the Study of Obesity (IASO) since 1998. Members are also encouraged to go into WO website at www.worldobesity.org for updated information on WO activities.

- ii) Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor is currently a member of the Membership Committee for WO.
- iii) Prof. Dr. Poh Bee Koon, represented Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor and MASO, to attend the World Obesity Annual General Meeting, which was held on 30th April 2019 at the European Congress on Obesity 2019 venue in Glasgow, Scotland. WO reported that their finances has improved over the past year, mostly due to more SCOPE and other activities, which helped to generate income.

b. Asia-Oceania Association for the Study of Obesity (AOASO)

- i) MASO is a pioneer member of Asia-Oceania Association for the Study of Obesity (AOASO) since its inception during the ICO 1998 in Paris.
- ii) The 2019 International Congress on Obesity and Metabolic Syndrome & Asia-Oceania Conference on Obesity (ICOMES & AOCO 2019) will be held at Seoul, Korea on 29- 31 August 2019. About 20 Malaysian researchers (under 45 years) have been awarded travel grant of USD500 by the Organiser (KSSO).
- iii) With the support of MyCEB, MASO have submitted "expression of interest" letter to AOASO to host AOCO 2021 in Kuala Lumpur and the bidding preparation will be led by Dr. Geeta Appannah with Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor as the Advisor.

c. Confederation of Scientific and Technological Associations in Malaysia (COSTAM)
